Dr. Hernando Garzon is the director of the Kaiser Permanente Global Health Program. He oversees and organizes resident global health experiences in Vietnam, Kenya, Zambia, Philippines, and Guatemala among others. There are a great many obstacles to resident and student involvement in Global Health, but Dr. Garzon has developed a robust resident presence across multiple sites worldwide.

#### **ABOUT THE SPEAKER**

Hernando Garzon, MD is Board Certified in Emergency Medicine and has practiced with Kaiser Permanente since 1992.

His 10 international disaster responses have been with multiple humanitarian relief organizations, and have included the Southeast Asia Tsunami in Sri Lanka, The Kashmir Earthquake in Pakistan, civil unrest situations in Kenya and Nigeria, the Haiti earthquake, the famine in Somalia, and most recently the Ebola outbreak in West Africa.

Dr. Garzon received the Permanente Medical Group exceptional contribution award in 2003, the David Lawrence Community Service award in 2010, and California's American College of Emergency Medicine's Humanitarian award in 2015. In years past, he has been recognized with a "Heros in Healthcare" award by the Red Cross in Yolo and Sacramento counties and by the Sacramento Business Journal.
