I focus on the child's function and performance, especially from their own perspective. My greatest professional joy is learning from a child or their parent that my intervention has improved their ability to accomplish a task that is important to them. My research interest is children's hand and arm function. I have served as Principal Investigator for several funded multi-center studies of children's hand and upper extremity function, and have published several prospective and retrospective studies of hand function in children. I also truly enjoy mentoring pre-medical, medical and post-graduate students.
