ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Junior faculty with a current NIH Career Development Award (K series) or similar

Post-doctoral fellows

Foreign post-doctoral fellows from 27 participating international sites in Lower-Middle Income Countries

Senior professional students (MD, DDS, DVM, PharmD, etc.) in health-related disciplines (human or animal) such as medicine, nursing, dentistry, optometry, etc.

Advanced doctoral students (PhD, DrPH, etc.) in fields such as health sciences, social and behavioral sciences, nutrition, environment, etc.

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA (UCGHI) GLOCAL HEALTH FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The University of California Global Health Institute (UCGHI) GloCal Health Fellowship is a career development fellowship sponsored by the Fogarty International Center (FIC). The consortium comprises four University of California campuses: UC San Francisco, UC San Diego, UC Los Angeles, UC Davis, and 27 affiliated international sites across 16 countries. This 11-month, mentored research fellowship program provides trainees with

outstanding, interdisciplinary education and training in innovative global health research designed to improve health for populations around the world. Trainees are matched with top-tier global health faculty program mentors, thus engaging in rich and enduring, mentored research experiences that will foster scientific and career development in global health research.
